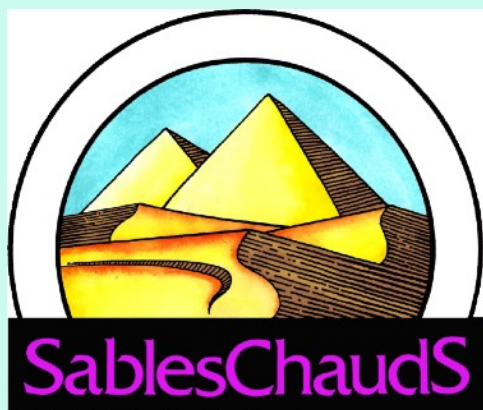




MOROCCO DREAMS 2026

"Let everything change so that nothing changes," says Alain Delon in *Le Guepard*. This will be the motto of our event, which will launch from the far north of Morocco, leaping from Fascinating Tangier, via a loop on the Mediterranean side/Atlantic side, to Heartbreaking Tetouan. The small roads of the Rif will then take us to Chefchaouen, whose Blue period recalls Picasso's at sunset, and Klein's at sunrise. Then we dive south towards Fez the Magician, an imperial city, a cultural capital of the old days, a fortified medina. And the great South: Arfoud the African, a bivouac in nowhere, and Aït Ben Haddou the Charming, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. And finally, the last two days in Marrakech the Unsurpassable, and its legendary La Mamounia hotel.



Programme

(Subject to possible modifications after recognition, but without changing the spirit of the test)

Arrival of participants on Friday 10 (additional night) or Saturday 11 April in Tangier.

Saturday, April 13 – Tangier

Administrative and technical checks in the afternoon. Nestled in the green hills of Tangier, with breathtaking sea views, we'll be staying at the brand new hotel, the Fairmont Tanzi Palace, featuring Arab-Andalusian architecture. Welcome dinner.

Sunday, April 14 – Tangier/Tetouan/Tamuda Bay

Where Morocco meets the Mediterranean: A beautiful motoring epic along the ocean. Our hotel, Le Royal

Mansour, is nestled in idyllic vegetation overlooking the Mediterranean coastline.

Monday, April 15 – Tamuda Bay/Chefchaouen/Fes

We leave the coast for the Rif Mountains and Chefchaouen, the blue city full of charm and authenticity. Then head to Fez, the magnificent city that needs no introduction. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Tuesday, April 16 – Fez/Arfoud

Descent to southern Morocco, passing through the cedar forest and its mischievous monkeys. Dinner and overnight stay at the Xaluca Hotel.



Wednesday, April 17 – Arfoud/Bivouac

Roads of southern Morocco...

Thursday, April 18 – Bivouac/Aït Ben Haddou

Magnificent Tizi N'Tazazert Pass. Lunch bivouac in the shade of a lake. Crossing the most beautiful palm grove in the Draa Valley. Ksar Ighnda Hotel.

Friday, April 19 – Aït Ben Haddou/Telouet/Tizi N'Tichka/Marrakech

Kasbah Route. Lunch in Asni at the incredible Kasbah Tamadot. Then return to Marrakech.

Dinner on your own. La Mamounia Hotel



Saturday, April 20 – Marrakech/Oukaïmeden/Marrakech

Two final regularity tests to build suspense.

Lunch by the pool at La Mamounia

Gala and Awards Ceremony Evening at La Mamounia.

Prices and options

Entry fees **12.850 Euros** for a crew and car. This price includes: 8 nights in a double room with breakfast, all meals (except Friday night), medical assistance, mechanical assistance (1 car and 1 sweeper truck), luggage transport, road book, maps, logbooks, average times tables, race numbers, rally plates, Blunik times and rankings, guarding and

security of vehicle parking lots, insurance in addition to your own, gifts (cap, bag, etc.), trophies, awards ceremony, etc.

Price for a "follow" or assistance car: Exactly the same services throughout the rally, but without the timing = **10.650 Euros**.
